## **Pronunciation of the Sounds in the English Language**

This is just a rough guide on pronunciation of the vowels and consonants.

| b  | bat            | re voiced and some voiceless, some are short and some are long short voiced sound, pronounced as the lips close and burst open                                  |  |
| С  | cat            | short unvoiced sound, pronounced in middle of tongue  |  |
| d  | duck           |   |  |
| f  | favourite      | short voiced sound, pronounced at the tip of the tongue   |  |
|    | lavounte       | long unvoiced sound pronounced with upper teeth sitting on inside of lower lip and air squeezing between teeth  |  |
| g  | gulp           | short voiced sound pronounced at the back of the throat   |  |
| h  | hop            | long unvoiced release of breath through an unobstructed throat and mouth  |  |
| j  | jump           | short voiced sound pronounced at the front of the tongue  |  |
| k  | king           | short unvoiced sound, pronounced in the middle of the tongue (see c)  |  |
| I  | ladder         | long voiced sound produced by raising the front of the tongue to sit on the palate, and air travels around the sides of it                                      |  |
| m  | monster        | long voiced sound, produced by air flowing through the nose   |  |
| n  | nose           | long voiced sound, the tongue sits on the palate and the mouth is ajar but the air flows through the nose and not mouth   |  |
| ng | song           | long voiced sound, produced at the back of the tongue – as if swallowing the sound  |  |
| р  | penguin        | short unvoiced sound, produced as the lips close and burst open   |  |
| qu | queen          | 2 sounds /cw/   |  |
| r  | rainbow        | long voiced sound, lips protruding forward and partially pursed, pronounced towards the back of the mouth, air flowing between tongue and palate                |  |
| S  | Sammy<br>snake | long unvoiced sound, front of tongue is on palate and air hisses between tongue and palate  |  |
| t  | teddy          | short unvoiced sound, produced at the tip of the tongue   |  |
| V  | vest           | long voiced sound, pronounced with upper teeth sitting on inside of lower lip and air squeezing between teeth   |  |
| W  | wobble         | voiced sound produced with tightly pursed lips, that needs to merge into the following vowel for full pronunciation   |  |
| X  | box            | 2 sounds both unvoiced - /ks/   |  |
| у  | уо-уо          | voiced sound produced with slightly protruding lips and sides of tongue raised to the palate, it needs to merge into the following vowel for full pronunciation |  |
| Z  | zip            | long voiced sound, front of tongue is on palate and air hisses between tongue and palate  |  |
| ch | chase          | short unvoiced sound pronounced at the front of the tongue  |  |
| sh | shiver         | long unvoiced sound, middle of tongue is on palate and air hisses between tongue and palate   |  |
| th | them           | long voiced sound, slightly curled tongue touching upper teeth  |  |
| th | thumb          | long unvoiced sound, slightly curled tongue touching upper teeth  |  |
| zj | treasure       | long voiced sound, middle of tongue is on palate and air hisses between tongue and palate   |  |

| Vowels: Vowels are pronounced with an open airway, minimal obstruction to airflow, and they are all <i>voiced</i> , they can have a long or short sound |                  |  |  |

| primary spelling  | word             | description of how to pronounce the vowel  |  |
| a   | apple            | wide open mouth as if taking a bite of an apple  |  |
| е   | egg              | open smiling mouth, pronounced at front of mouth   |  |
| i   | ink              | sharp sound at the back of the throat & slightly screw up nose and raise upper lip, pronounced near front of mouth |  |
| 0   | orange<br>on off | pursed lips into an 'o' shape, pronounced near back of tongue  |  |
| 00  | look             | short voiced sound, lips slightly pursed, pronounced in the middle of the mouth                                    |  |
| u   | up               | make sound in throat as if swallowing it   |  |
| ay  | aim              | open mouth smile, pronounced mid mouth   |  |
| ee  | feet             | smile with mouth slightly ajar, pronounced near front of tongue  |  |
| igh   | light            | mouth dropped open, pronounced mid tongue  |  |
| OW  | toad             | pursed lips into o-shape, pronounced mid tongue  |  |
| ew  | boot             | outward protruding pursed lips, pronounced at back of tongue   |  |
| oi  | boy              | lips initially pursed as in 'o', and then they open out into smile as in 'ee'                                      |  |
| ur  | turn             | half dropped jaw, open airway  |  |
| air   | chair            | half open, half smiling mouth, jaw dropped and open airway, draw mid-tongue/jaw up slightly to complete sound      |  |
| ear   | hear             | half smile, mid tongue raised up to top of mouth to reduce air flow, then partly release tongue and smile          |  |
| ar  | car              | mouth and tongue dropped open  |  |
| or  | horn             | pursed lips, jaw and tongue dropped  |  |
| OW  | clown            | open mouth and dropped jaw, lips become pursed   |  |
