Swimming has started so well and the children have loved it, we have been so lucky with the weather. Thank you to everyone who has volunteered to help and to Laila for organising the rota. For any parents who haven't seen the pool before I am offering a quick tour at 8.45am on Monday 13th May. Please come along to the school office.

Looking ahead at the class swimming rotas next week there are still some empty slots for the sessions. Swimming can only take place with a lot of parental support. We are grateful to everyone who has put their name on the rota, if you have requested a DBS check and it is complete please add your name to the rota where you are able to help, thank you. Unfortunately we will have no alternative but to cancel swimming if we do not have enough volunteers to make the sessions safe and manageable. Thank you for your ongoing support.

Swimming - naming kit and buying hats

A reminder that all items of clothing must be named, including shoes, underwear, towels, and costumes as they can go astray in the changing rooms. Swimming hats are available for purchase on Parentpay and we will put the hat into your child's bag after you have placed your order on Parentpay. If your child has long hair please ensure that this is tied up for swimming, it is very difficult for the children to put on their hat if their hair is long and untied. Please also avoid tights on swim days as they are very difficult to put on after a swim.

Vomiting and diarrhoea - 48 hours absence from school

We would like to remind you that if your child has vomited or has had a bout of diarrhoea they <u>MUST</u> stay at home for a full 48 hours after their last bout. Even if they vomit once or have one bout of diarrhoea and then appear to be well they may still be contagious for a further 48 hours. Keeping them away from school is so important in helping us to contain the spread of tummy bugs to other children and to staff. If you are at all unsure about whether your child should attend school if they have been sick or have had diarrhoea, please call the School Office from 8am to check <u>before</u> sending your child into school. We are grateful to everyone who observes this.

Volunteering in school - DBS checks

If you would like to help with swimming, trips or any other activity in school and do not yet have a DBS check through the school, please come to the school office to collect the application forms, or you can email <u>admin@chi.rbksch.org</u> and we will put them in your child's blue bag. If you have completed a DBS check with us and have received your certificate in the post, we <u>must</u> see the certificate for our records, to complete the process. Please bring your certificate to the school office as soon as you receive it for us to take a copy. We also encourage you to sign up for the DBS update service (free to volunteers) within 28 days of receiving your certificate, <u>DBS Update Service - GOV.UK</u>. DBS certificates are valid for three years, if you need to check if you still have a valid certificate with us please contact the school office.

Pupil Premium Grant

When your child was admitted to the school we checked their eligibility for the Pupil Premium Grant. Please get in touch with us if your financial circumstances have changed since your child's eligibility was checked and you think you may now be eligible.
